

# Tuning by Ear

To tune your guitar by ear, start by tuning your low E string to the **“Low E String Video Example”** in the Tuning section of the DVD.

Once you have the Low E string in tune, you can tune the rest of the strings to it.

Start by playing the 5<sup>th</sup> fret of the 6<sup>th</sup> string and match the open 5<sup>th</sup> string to it:

Proceed by playing 5<sup>th</sup> fret of the 5<sup>th</sup> string and match the open 4<sup>th</sup> string to it.

Proceed by playing 5<sup>th</sup> fret of the 4<sup>th</sup> string and match the open 3<sup>rd</sup> string to it.

Proceed by playing 4<sup>th</sup> fret of the 3<sup>rd</sup> string and match the open 2<sup>nd</sup> string to it.

Proceed by playing 5<sup>th</sup> fret of the 2<sup>nd</sup> string and match the open 1<sup>st</sup> string to it
